**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO
RATIFYING AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF THE
2010 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CH2M HILL, INC.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 31-15-101, C.R.S., the City Council of the City of Castle Pines has the authority to enter into contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously entered into an agreement for professional services with CH2M Hill, Inc. ("CH2"), effective as of August 15, 2008, as amended, for city management services, as amended (Collectively, the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City provided written notice of termination to CH2M on December 1, 2010 and is currently negotiating with CH2 regarding a revised scope of services for services in 2011; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 10.2 of the Agreement, the City and CH2 desire to extend the term of the Agreement through and including January 31, 2011.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CASTLE PINES, COLORADO:

Section 1. In accordance with Section 10.2 of the Agreement, the City Council hereby authorizes and ratifies the extension of the term of the CH2M Hill, Inc. Agreement for a period of approximately thirty (30) days through and including January 31, 2011.

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining issues of this Resolution.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council.
